Ascription of Praise

Requiem by John Rutter was first performed in October of 1985. It is made up of a personal selection of texts from the Requiem mass and from the 1662 Book of Common Prayer.

The seven sections of the work form an archlike meditation on the themes of life and death: the first and last movements are prayers on behalf of all humanity; movements two and six are Psalm settings; the third and fifth are personal prayers to Christ; the central "Sanctus" is an affirmation of divine glory.
