Ascription of Praise

Requiem by John Rutter was first performed in October of 1985. It is made up of a personal selection of texts from the Requiem mass and from the 1662 *Book of Common Prayer*.

The seven sections of the work form an arch-like meditation on the themes of life and death: the first and last movements are prayers on behalf of all humanity; movements two and six are Psalm settings; the third and fifth are personal prayers to Christ; the central "Sanctus" is an affirmation of divine glory.
