


Since the penning of the original objectives for this school and on through the years to the presentation today, music has been a key theme in the life of EMHS.

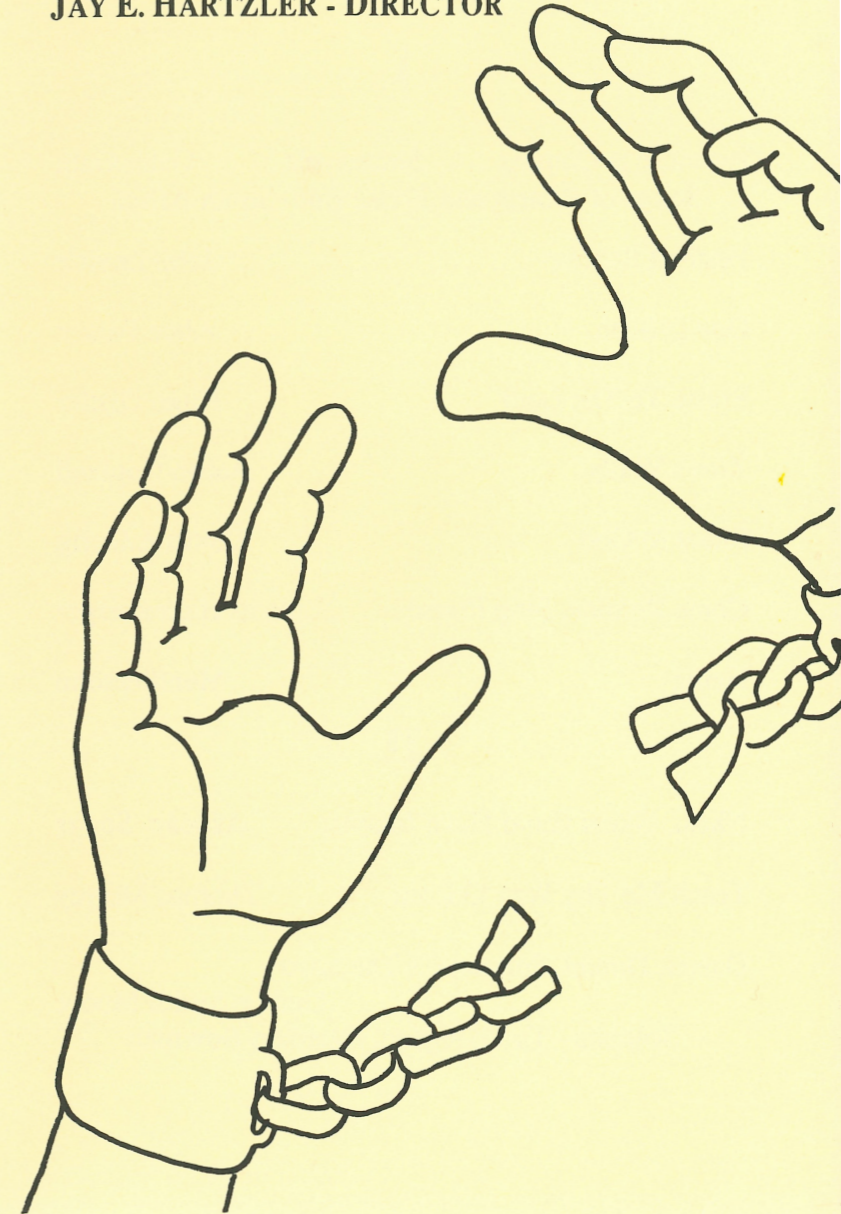
